Research achievements

[At the start of my scientific career, the main interest in my experimental neurology projects were apoptosis and cell signalling in neurodegeneration and my main scientific contribution refers mainly to neurobiology, biomarkers and mechanisms of neurodegenerative diseases. However, over time, I had the chance to work in both clinical and experimental research, and I supervised 12 students who graduated their PhDs with different projects, most of them linked to neurodegeneration.
